Port Hacking

Contact has been made with our counterparts at RMYC Port Hacking and the following has been arranged.

- 12:30 Lunch at RMYC Port Hacking in their restaurant. This is similar in style and prices to our Club Brasserie.
- 14:00 Pick up at the RMYC wharf by the MV Tom Thumb for a 3 hour cruise to the upper reaches of Port Hacking. There is a \$25 per head charge for this, although once we have the final numbers we should be able to negotiate this downwards.
- 17:00 Return to RMYC Port Hacking.



The ferry is skippered by a member of the RMYC Port Hacking Sailing Division and will take us to all points of interest including Jibbon Beach, Bundeena, Salmon Haul and tide permitting we maybe able to get up as far as the Audley Weir in the Royal National Park. Other members of the RMYC sailing division may be present at the lunch and/or cruise and will be able to give us a commentary as to points of interest for yachtsmen and yachtswomen,

Those members interested in participating in this unique event, could you please let me know by Monday 2nd August so as bookings for lunch and ferry cruise can be firmed up. Also there will be the opportunity to perhaps arrange some car pooling between us for the drive down and back.
